How to find and KeyCite a case by name in FamilySource

Welcome to this tutorial on how to find and KeyCite a case by name in FamilySource.

To find a case by name, select the Family Law Cases and Decisions link and then select Find and KeyCite a Case by Name. In the template provided, enter all or part of the name into the Name field and select a jurisdiction from the drop-down list, if know. Select Search. A results list appears displaying cases matching your terms. You can use the filters in the Narrow section to further restrict your list; or if you know the case you want, simply select its name to retrieve the full text.

To view the history of the case, select the History tab and to see where this case has been cited in other cases and secondary sources, select the Citing Reference tab. This ends your tutorial on how to find and KeyCite a case by name in FamilySource.

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
