How to find and KeyCite a case by citation in FamilySource

Welcome to this tutorial on how to find and KeyCite a case by citation in FamilySource.

To find a case by citation, enter the citation into the search box located at the top of any WestlawNext Canada page and then select Search. Note that the search box is not sensitive to spacing, capitalization, or punctuation used for abbreviations.

A results list appears displaying cases matching your terms. In this example we can choose between the English and French versions. Select the version you wish to retrieve. If only one version is available, the full text of the case would have been automatically retrieved.

To view the history of the case, select the History tab and to see where this case has been cited in other cases and secondary sources, select the Citing Reference tab. Use the links in the View section to narrow your list to the document type you wish to see... and then use the customized filters to further restrict your list, if you wish.
