How to find and KeyCite a statutory provision by name in FamilySource

Welcome to this tutorial on how to find and KeyCite a statutory provision by name in FamilySource.

From the WestlawNext Canada home page, select the Find and KeyCite by Name tab and then select Find and KeyCite a Statute or Regulation by Name. Enter the name of the statute and section number into the fields provided; select a jurisdiction, and then select **Search**. A results list appears displaying documents that match your terms. In this example, we've retrieved both the English and French versions of the provision. Select the document name to retrieve the full text.

Alternatively, you can browse legislation by selecting the Family Law Statutes and Regulations link from the FamilySource start page and then linking through to the provision you want.

To KeyCite the provision, select the Citing Reference tab to retrieve the full list of cases and secondary sources. You can narrow your list by selecting a document type to view: either Cases and Decisions or Secondary Sources. Once you have selected a document type, customized filters appear on the left side providing you with additional options for narrowing your list to only those decisions you want.
