How to search for a case name when the parties are protected

Welcome to this tutorial on how to search for a case name when the parties are protected.

To find the full text of a case where the parties are protected, select the Family Law Cases and Decisions link then select the Find and KeyCite a Case by Name link. In the template provided, enter the initials within quotation marks into the name field. Note that you do not need to include the punctuation. Select the jurisdiction, if known, and then select Search. If the results list yields multiple hits, use the filters in the Narrow section to further restrict your results. To retrieve the full text of a decision, select its name. To learn more about FamilySource, please review the other tutorials on this topic.
