In the coming year, we plan consolidations for the following titles of the Case Law Digests component of the Abridgment:

- Municipal Law
- Public Law

This reissue of the Municipal Law and Public Law titles provides an opportunity to significantly update and modernize these titles, taking into account developments within each field since their last consolidations in 2012 and 2013, respectively.

Effective September 3, 2019, we have simplified our invoice and your product price now includes standard shipping (previously shown as separate amounts). Accordingly, the estimated upkeep costs of our Abridgment products includes standard shipping.
