Highlights:

In the coming year, we plan a reconsolidation of the Insurance Law title on Westlaw Canada and Westlaw Edge Canada.

The reissue of the Insurance Law title provides an opportunity to significantly update and modernize this title, taking into account developments within the field since the last reconsolidation in 2011.

Effective September 3, 2019, we have simplified our invoice, and your product price now includes standard shipping (previously shown as separate amounts). Accordingly, the estimated upkeep costs of our Abridgment products include standard shipping.

While we endeavour to provide you with the most accurate prices and publishing dates, it is not possible to state with absolute certainty the number of volumes, month of publication, and price at this time.
