

FROM THE PUBLISHER

The December 2015 Bulletin referenced the planned reissue of the Criminal Law title of the Case Law Digests component of the Canadian Abridgment in 2016. In light of the size and complexity of the Criminal Law reissue initiative, we have determined that it will take more than a year to complete the work. Consequently, we have decided to prioritize the publication of the reconsolidation of the Canadian Case Citations in 2016 (which otherwise would have been planned for publication in 2017), and to defer publication of the Criminal Law reissue until 2017.

This revised Bulletin includes the anticipated publishing schedule and an estimate of the prices of our Abridgment products for the upcoming year. I welcome any comments or suggestions that you may have concerning The Canadian Abridgment.

Highlights:

There are two reconsolidations planned for 2016.

- Reconsolidation of the Canadian Case Citations component of the Canadian Abridgment. This replaces the previously-planned reissue of the Criminal Law case law digests, which has been moved to 2017.

This reconsolidation is necessary, both because the number of supplement volumes now exceeds the number of main work volumes and because the supplements are now becoming too large to bind. Thanks to a technical enhancement, this reconsolidation will also add an additional 265,000 Quebec case citations to the product. We expect the reconsolidation to comprise 53 volumes.

- Reconsolidation of the Regulations volumes of the Canadian Statute Citations.

The Regulations volumes must be reconsolidated because the supplement volumes are becoming too large to bind. We expect the reconsolidation to comprise 6 volumes.

While we endeavour to provide you with the most accurate prices and publishing dates, it is not possible at this time to state with absolute certainty the number of volumes, month of publication, and price. All prices are estimates and may change. An outline of the 2016 program as it is currently planned follows, and we will keep you informed of any changes as the year unfolds.
